29-JUL: - KIRINYAGA

The next morning, 29th July, your driver picks you up for a scenic drive of approximately 140-150 km (about 2.5 to 3 hours) northeast to Kirinyaga. You arrive at the historic Castle Forest Lodge, tucked deep within the ancient forests on the southern slopes of Mount Kenya. This full-board stay includes a refreshing nature walk amid towering trees and birdsong, offering a perfect introduction to Kenya's highlands.

30 JUL : - MT. KENYA

On 30th July, you continue your journey deeper into the Mount Kenya region (a short drive of roughly 1-1.5 hours) to the iconic Mt. Kenya Safari Club. Surrounded by dramatic mountain scenery, you enjoy full-board accommodation and a peaceful 2.5-hour nature walk in the conservancy, soaking in the cool mountain air and stunning views.

31 JUL: - OL PAJETA

This day starts with a leisurely breakfast followed by a 2 hour walk in the Mt. Kenya forest. You will later on a short distance (about 18-25 km, 30-45 minutes) enter into Ol Pejeta Conservancy, where you check into Serena Sweetwaters for two nights. This full-board stay includes a guided 2.5-hour walk in the Mforest, plus park fees. Ol Pejeta is famous for its rhino sanctuary and chimpanzee rescue, offering incredible close encounters with wildlife

1 AUG-OL PAJETA

This day is dedicated to exploration right from your base at Serena Sweetwaters. Enjoy a thrilling game drive across the conservancy's vast landscapes, with full-board meals and park fees included, as you search for the Big Five against the backdrop of Mount Kenya.

2 AUG: - LK NAIVASHA

On 2nd August, you make the scenic journey southwest from Ol Pejeta to Lake Naivasha, covering approximately 150–200 km (around 3 to 4 hours) with a stop over at Thompson Falls.

You'll arrive at the charming Malu Lodge on the lake shores. Enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the freshwater lake, spotting hippos and abundant birdlife, followed by a visit to Crescent Island for a gentle walking safari.

3 AUG: - MASAI MARA

This is the highlight many dream of: the drive to the Masai Mara (approximately 240-270 km, 5 to 6 hours). You head to Wilderness Basecamp in the Naboisho Conservancy (part of the greater Mara ecosystem). After a hearty lunch, you dive into afternoon game drives, followed by dinner. This full experience, including park fees, immerses you in the legendary wildlife haven.

AUG 4-MASAI MARA

Today is pure magic at Eagle View Saruni. Wake up for a spectacular balloon flight with champagne breakfast over the Mara plains at sunrise—one of the most iconic experiences in Africa. Return for a full day of game drives with a packed lunch, more wildlife viewing, dinner, and park fees.

AUG-5-MASAI MARA

You continue the safari excitement as you transfer a short distance to Sarova Mara. GENERAL INFORMATION:

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

All visitors to Kenya must have a valid passport with at least 4 consecutive blank pages.

Any applicable Travel Documents are the responsibility of the traveller. For further information on Travel permit requirements visitors are advised to contact their nearest Kenyan Embassy or Consulate.

LOCAL SIM CARDS:

They can be purchased at the airport on arrival as they require passport verification. You can load our local currency in the M-Pesa app which makes it easy for you to purchase without getting refunds inconveniences.

WI-FI:

City hotels have it available in all areas but it might be limited the common areas in the lodges depending on the lodge.

POWER:

The city and Town hotels have 24-hour coverage but in the lodges within the parks, they always advise on when they put off their generators mostly at midnight and in the afternoon when all guests have left for afternoon game drives. For special considerations like CPAP machine use, it is good to notify the hotel earlier.

VOLTAGE:

220 Volts/AC50Hz. Sockets are UK style, 3 pin square plugs. Power is from the National Grid in the city/major towns and generator with inverter back up in the Safari Lodges and Camps.

**CURRENCY:**

Foreign currency must be changed at the Bank, Bureau de Change, and Hotel/Safari lodge/Camp/Resort. Major Credit Cards, Master card, Visa, American Express, are usually accepted throughout the country. Where credit cards are accepted, the payment will normally be recorded in US\$ regardless of the card's default currency.

CLOTHING:

Dress is mainly informal and should be comfortable as well as practical. Something warm should be brought along for early morning and evenings. Safari clothes are available from hotels/lodges/camps.

BAGGAGE:

Where possible, travel light. Baggage space on safari is limited to medium suitcase or soft bag per person plus reasonable amount of hand luggage. There is 15 Kilogram per person limit on all flights to the wildlife sanctuaries. Excess luggage must be stored in your arrival hotel.

WATER:

You will find many different of opinion of what is safe and what is not. We recommend for peace of mind, to drink local Bottled Mineral water. It is important to drink plenty of water especially during the hotter months. We would recommend that guests drink at least 2 to 3 litres of water per day to limit the effects of dehydration.

DRINKS:

Drinks are only paid for in the All Inclusive packages. Drinks are always charged separately from the Full Board package

HEALTH;

East Africa is a safe and secure destination; however, it is a good idea to take a few precautions. Kindly consult your GP or local doctor at least 6 weeks before you travel, with regards:

Malaria prophylactics. East Africa is a known malaria area and preventive measures are essential. You are advised to take one of the recommended anti-malarial drugs. Also confirm on Yellow Fever Vaccine compliance. Be sure to wear long sleeved shorts and trousers after sunset and spray the exposed parts of your body with a mosquito repellent spray

Remember to protect yourself from direct sun rays with sunscreen cream or safari hat.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS:

For those guests with specific dietary requirement, please ensure the Hotel is notified prior to travel

GRATUITIES:

As a guideline and dependent on how happy you are, we would suggest the following:

The General Hotel/Lodge/Camp Staff - Approximately US\$ 10.00 per person per day

Driver Guides – Approximately US\$ 20.00 to US\$ 40.00 per person per day

PHOTOGRAPHY AND BINOCULARS:
