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## **10 JUNE: TSAVO EAST**

Your journey begins in the tranquil coastal setting of **Ukunda** (Diani Beach area).

After an early breakfast at your hotel, the private **Landcruiser** arrives to pick you up around 6:30–7:00 AM.

You settle in for the scenic drive northward, covering approximately **300–320 km** that should take about 5 to 6.5 hours depending on traffic around the Likoni Ferry and Mombasa city.

The route follows the coastal roads before joining the main Mombasa–Nairobi highway, passing through changing landscapes from lush coconut palms and farmlands to drier savannah as you approach Tsavo.

By early to mid-afternoon, you reach the area of **Tsavo East National Park**, and you continue a short distance into the adjacent **Ngutuni Sanctuary**, a beautiful 10,000-acre private conservancy bordering Tsavo East on three sides.

You check into your accommodation at **Ngutuni Sanctuary** in the early afternoon. After a refreshing lunch at the lodge, you head out for an afternoon game drive.

The red-dust plains of Tsavo and Ngutuni come alive with sightings of elephants (often coated in the characteristic red soil), lions, buffaloes, giraffes, zebras, and various antelopes.

As the sun begins to set, you return to the lodge for a relaxing dinner and overnight stay, with the sounds of the African bush lulling you to sleep.

## **11 -13 JUNE: MOMBASA**

The next day starts with an early breakfast and checkout from Ngutuni.

Your **Landcruiser** is ready for the day's transport leg. This is primarily a travel day with an extended game drive before heading back toward the coast. The drive from the Tsavo East / Ngutuni area to **Mombasa** covers roughly **170–200 km** along the main highway and typically takes 3 to 4 hours under normal conditions.

You arrive at the vibrant North Coast in the afternoon and check into the beautiful **Sarova Whitesands Beach Resort & Spa** on Bamburi Beach. The property offers half board, so you can enjoy a leisurely dinner with sea views after settling in. The remainder of the day is yours to unwind by the pool or take a gentle stroll along the white sands of the Indian Ocean.

**12 June** and **13 June** unfold as blissful beach days at **Sarova Whitesands**.

Mornings begin with a hearty breakfast at the resort. You have full freedom to relax however you wish — swimming in the calm ocean waters, lounging under palm trees on the expansive beach, enjoying the hotel's swimming pools, or indulging in optional activities such as snorkeling, beach walks, or a spa treatment.

The half board arrangement covers breakfast and dinner, allowing you to savor fresh seafood and international cuisine while watching the waves.

These two days provide the perfect recovery and contrast after the safari experience, letting you soak in the coastal serenity without any major travel.

#### **14-JUNE-EX-MOMBASA**

Finally, after a relaxed breakfast and checkout from Sarova Whitesands (usually by 10:00 or 11:00 AM), a **taxi** arrives for your airport transfer.

The short journey to **Moi International Airport** covers only about **20–25 km** and normally takes 25 to 40 minutes, though it's wise to allow extra time for Mombasa traffic.

You arrive at the airport well in advance of your flight, bringing a wonderful close to this mix of wildlife adventure and beach relaxation.
