## 5-OCT: NAIROBI - MAASAI MARA

After a leisurely breakfast, it is time to proceed to the airport to catch your flight to Masai Mara. On arrival at the airstrip, our Safari Guides will pick you and you will proceed to the lodge with a game drive en route to the lodge.

You'll arrive at the **Sarova Mara Game Camp** around 13:30 PM, just in time for a late lunch. After checking into your luxurious tented room, the wild calls once more.

At 4:00 PM, you embark on your first **Maasai Mara game drive**. This is where the magic of the savannah truly comes alive. Your guide will expertly track the Big Five and the countless other animals that call this reserve home.

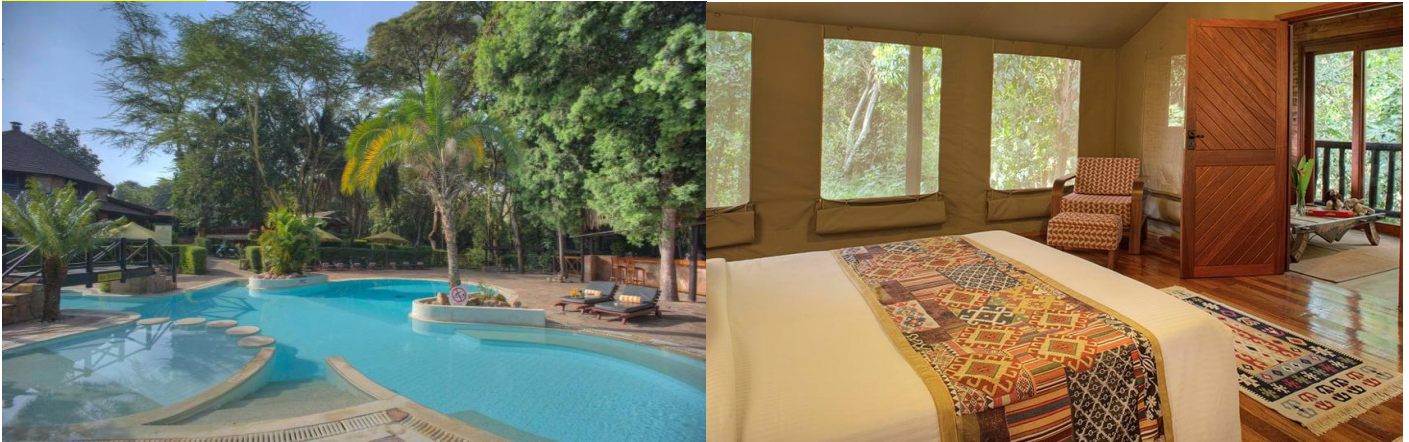
As the golden hour approaches, you'll stop for a classic "sundowner view" after having visited a nearby **Maasai Village** (typically an hour-long visit), where you'll be welcomed with traditional song and dance, witness the astonishing jumping prowess of the Moran warriors, and step inside a traditional homestead to learn about their ancient way of life.

Later on, you will visit the camp's **Beads Museum** to admire the intricate and symbolic artistry of Maasai craftsmanship.

Return to the lodge by 6:30 PM, with hearts full from the sights and sounds of the Mara. After dinner, you have the option for a unique cultural immersion with the Masai Dancers.

***You can opt to have a special sundowner with cocktails @ USD 60 per person before heading back to the lodge or a bush dinner later in the night at USD 70 per person.***

## 6-OCT: FULL DAY IN MAASAI MARA

Today is dedicated entirely to the wonders of the Maasai Mara. You have two options for the day:

### Option 1: The Full Day Explorer

Rise before the sun for a quick cup of coffee or tea, and set out on a **full-day game drive at 6:30 AM**. Your Landcruiser becomes your mobile viewing platform as you venture deep into the reserve, armed with a packed picnic lunch. This extended exploration allows you to reach remote areas teeming with wildlife and follow the drama of predator and prey throughout the day. You'll return to the lodge, wonderfully weary, by 4:30 PM.

### Option 2: The Leisurely Pursuit

Enjoy a more relaxed morning with a full breakfast at the lodge. Embark on a game drive at **8:00 AM for 3-4 hours**, returning for lunch and some time to relax by the pool. Later, venture out again for a final **afternoon game drive from 4:00 PM to 6:30 PM**, capturing the Mara in its most beautiful light.

Whichever option you choose, the day will be filled with unforgettable moments—a lion pride lounging in the sun, a solitary leopard draped over an acacia branch, or a thunderous herd of elephants moving with ancient grace.

Enjoy your final night under the vast, star-studded African sky at the Sarova Mara. **Optional Balloon Flight at USD 450 per person**

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## 7,8 & 9 OCT: -DIANI

Savour one last delicious breakfast in the wild, listening to the chorus of birds. Around 1030hrs, you'll board your flight **to Nairobi**. You'll be land at Wilson Airport and transferred to Jomo Kenyatta Airport to catch your flight to Diani arriving in the afternoon.

***Alternatively, you can fly directly from Masai Mara to Diani at an extra cost of USD 40 per person.***

Our representative will be waiting for you to drive you to your Baobab Beach Resort where you will be on All Inclusive which caters for some selection of drinks for 2 nights. Relax in the afternoon by the Beach as you book for beach activities on day to day basis.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

All visitors to Kenya must have a valid passport with at least 4 consecutive blank pages.

Any applicable Travel Documents are the responsibility of the traveller. For further information on Travel permit requirements visitors are advised to contact their nearest Kenyan Embassy or Consulate.

### **LOCAL SIM CARDS:**

They can be purchased at the airport on arrival as they require passport verification. You can load our local currency in the M-Pesa app which makes it easy for you to purchase without getting refunds inconveniences.

### **WI-FI:**

City hotels have it available in all areas but it might be limited the common areas in the lodges depending on the lodge.

### **POWER:**

The city and Town hotels have 24-hour coverage but in the lodges within the parks, they always advise on when they put off their generators mostly at midnight and in the afternoon when all guests have left for afternoon game drives. For special considerations like CPAP machine use, it is good to notify the hotel earlier.

### **LANGUAGE:**

Kiswahili and English

### **TIME:**

GMT +3

### **VOLTAGE:**

220 Volts/AC50Hz. Sockets are UK style, 3 pin square plugs. Power is from the National Grid in the city/major towns and generator with inverter back up in the Safari Lodges and Camps.



### **CURRENCY:**

Foreign currency must be changed at the Bank, Bureau de Change, and Hotel/Safari lodge/Camp/Resort. Major Credit Cards, Master card, Visa, American Express, are usually accepted throughout the country.

Where credit cards are accepted, the payment will normally be recorded in US\$ regardless of the card's default currency.

**CLOTHING:**

Dress is mainly informal and should be comfortable as well as practical. Something warm should be brought along for early morning and evenings. Safari clothes are available from hotels/lodges/camps.

**BAGGAGE:**

Where possible, travel light. Baggage space on safari is limited to medium suitcase or soft bag per person plus reasonable amount of hand luggage. There is 15 Kilogram per person limit on all flights to the wildlife sanctuaries. Excess luggage must be stored in your arrival hotel.

**WATER:**

You will find many different of opinion of what is safe and what is not. We recommend for peace of mind, to drink local Bottled Mineral water. It is important to drink plenty of water especially during the hotter months. We would recommend that guests drink at least 2 to 3 litres of water per day to limit the effects of dehydration.

**HEALTH:**

East Africa is a safe and secure destination; however, it is a good idea to take a few precautions. Kindly consult your GP or local doctor at least 6 weeks before you travel, with regards:

Malaria prophylactics. East Africa is a known malaria area and preventive measures are essential. You are advised to take one of the recommended anti-malarial drugs. Also confirm on Yellow Fever Vaccine compliance. Be sure to wear long sleeved shorts and trousers after sunset and spray the exposed parts of your body with a mosquito repellent spray

Remember to protect yourself from direct sun rays with sunscreen cream or safari hat.

**DIETARY REQUIREMENTS:**

For those guests with specific dietary requirement, please ensure the Hotel is notified prior to travel

**GRATUITIES:**

As a guideline and dependent on how happy you are, we would suggest the following:

The General Hotel/Lodge/Camp Staff - Approximately US\$ 10.00 per person per day

Driver Guides – Approximately US\$ 15.00 to US\$ 20.00 per person per day

**PHOTOGRAPHY AND BINOCULARS:**

It is good to carry along binoculars as we may not provide for everyone and also a great camera to capture the moments.

Please ensure that you have sought permission before photographing local people and their villages. If in doubt, please check with your guide.
