## **DAY 1: MONDAY, 30TH SEPTEMBER - ARRIVAL & NAIROBI**

**Morning/Afternoon:** Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO). Meet and greet by your driver.

**Afternoon:** Check into your hotel. Depending on your arrival time, you may have time for a brief rest.

**Afternoon-Nairobi National Park visit** by 2 pax

**Evening:Dinner:** At The Boma Hotel.

**Accommodation:** The Boma, Nairobi.

**Travel Today:** 10 minutes (from airport to hotel, depending on traffic).

## **DAY 2: TUESDAY, 1ST OCTOBER - JOURNEY TO THE ABERDARE HIGHLANDS**

**Focus:** Scenic drive to the highlands, overnight game viewing at The Ark.

**Morning:** After breakfast, depart Nairobi by Landcruiser. Drive north through agricultural heartlands with views of Mount Kenya.

**Travel:** Nairobi to Aberdare National Park (The Ark area).

**Distance:** ~180 km **Time:** ~3.5 - 4 hours

**Lunch:** Likely at the Aberdare Country Club or a similar base hotel before transfer to The Ark.

**Afternoon/Evening:** Check into The Ark. This unique lodge is built over a waterhole and salt lick.

Spend the afternoon and evening on the lodge's viewing decks, watching elephants, buffalo, rhinos, and various antelope that come to drink.

**Accommodation:** The Ark, Aberdare National Park.

## **DAY 3: WEDNESDAY 2ND OCTOBER - TO THE FOOTHILLS & OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY**

**Focus:** Descend to the Laikipia Plateau and explore the renowned Ol Pejeta Conservancy.

**Morning:** After an early breakfast, depart The Ark. Drive down into the Laikipia Plateau.

**Travel:** Aberdare to Ol Pejeta Conservancy.

**Distance:** ~80 km **Time:** ~2 hours

**Late Morning:** Enter Ol Pejeta Conservancy. Enjoy a morning game drive en route to your camp. Ol Pejeta is home to the last two remaining northern white rhinos on Earth and a chimpanzee sanctuary.

**Lunch:** At Ol Pejeta Bush Camp.

**Afternoon:** Enjoy an afternoon game drive, visiting the chimpanzee sanctuary and the rhino information center.

**Accommodation:** Ol Pejeta Bush Camp.

## **DAY 4: THURSDAY, 3<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER - NORTH TO SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE**

**Focus:** Journey into the arid, beautiful landscapes of Samburu.

**Morning:** After breakfast, depart Ol Pejeta. Drive north, crossing the equator and witnessing the landscape change to semi-desert.

**Travel:** Ol Pejeta to Samburu National Reserve (Ashnil Samburu).

**Distance:** ~150 km **Time:** ~3 - 3.5 hours

**Afternoon:** Arrive at Ashnil Samburu Camp, check-in, and have lunch. Embark on your first afternoon game drive in Samburu, looking for the "Special Five": Grevy's zebra, Somali ostrich, gerenuk, Beisa oryx, and the reticulated giraffe.

**Accommodation:** Ashnil Samburu, Samburu National Reserve.

### **DAY 5: FRIDAY, 3RD APRIL - FULL DAY IN SAMBURU**

**Focus:** Extensive wildlife viewing in Samburu.

**Morning:** Early morning game drive when animals are most active.

**Mid-day:** Return to the lodge for breakfast and relaxation during the heat of the day.

**Afternoon:** Another game drive, perhaps focusing on the Ewaso Ng'iro river, where elephants and crocodiles are often seen.

**Accommodation:** Ashnil Samburu, Buffalo National Reserve.

### **DAY 6: SATURDAY, 4TH APRIL - ANOTHER DAY IN SAMBURU**

**Focus:** Further exploration for a full day.

**Full Day:** You have the option for a full day of game drives with a picnic lunch.

**Accommodation:** Ashnil Samburu, Buffalo National Reserve.

### **DAY 7: SUNDAY, 5TH APRIL - SOUTH TO NANYUKI**

**Focus:** A final game drive in Lewa before heading back to the famous Mt. Kenya Safari Club Resort for full board accommodation.

**Morning:** After an early breakfast, check out and drive south to the Lewa Wildlife Conservancy.

**Travel:** Samburu to Lewa Conservancy.

**Distance:** ~120 km **Time:** ~2.5 - 3 hours

**Late Morning:** Enter Lewa Conservancy (famous for its rhino conservation). Enjoy a final, scenic game drive within Lewa.

**Travel:** Lewa Conservancy to Nanyuki.

**Distance:** ~250 km **Time:** ~1.45 - 2 hours

**Late Afternoon:** Indoor nature walk or any other activities within the resort

**Evening:Dinner:** At The Boma Hotel.

**Accommodation:** The Boma, Nairobi.

**Park Fees:** Lewa Conservancy paid.

### **DAY 8: MONDAY, 6TH APRIL – DEPARTURE**

**Late Afternoon:** Arrive back in Nairobi.

**Evening:Dinner:** At The Boma Hotel.

**Accommodation:** The Boma, Nairobi.

**Focus:** Last-minute souvenirs and departure.

**Morning:** After breakfast and check-out, you will be transferred to the Kazuri Beads Factory & Workshop. This is a wonderful opportunity to see how beautiful ceramic beads and pottery are made and to support local women artisans. You can purchase souvenirs here.

**Mid-day:** After your visit, you will be transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) for your departure flight.

**Travel Today:** ~25 km / ~45 minutes - 1.5 hours (depending on time of day and traffic to the airport).

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

All visitors to Kenya must have a valid passport with at least 4 consecutive blank pages. Any applicable Travel Documents are the responsibility of the traveller. For further information on Travel permit requirements visitors are advised to contact their nearest Kenyan Embassy or Consulate. <https://www.etakenya.go.ke/en>

#### **LOCAL SIM CARDS:**

They can be purchased at the airport on arrival as they require passport verification. You can load our local currency in the M-Pesa app which makes it easy for you to purchase without getting refunds inconveniences.

#### **WI-FI:**

City hotels have it available in all areas but it might be limited the common areas in the lodges depending on the lodge.

#### **POWER:**

The city and Town hotels have 24-hour coverage but in the lodges within the parks, they always advise on when they put off their generators mostly at midnight and in the afternoon when all guests have left for afternoon game drives. For special considerations like CPAP machine use, it is good to notify the hotel earlier.

#### **LANGUAGE:**

Kiswahili and English

#### **TIME:**

GMT +3

#### **VOLTAGE:**

220 Volts/AC50Hz. Sockets are UK style, 3 pin square plugs. Power is from the National Grid in the city/major towns and generator with inverter back up in the Safari Lodges and Camps.



### **CURRENCY:**

Foreign currency must be changed at the Bank, Bureau de Change, and Hotel/Safari lodge/Camp/Resort. Major Credit Cards, Master card, Visa, American Express, are usually accepted throughout the country. Where credit cards are accepted, the payment will normally be recorded in US\$ regardless of the card's default currency.

### **CLOTHING:**

Dress is mainly informal and should be comfortable as well as practical. Something warm should be brought along for early morning and evenings. Safari clothes are available from hotels/lodges/camps.

### **BAGGAGE:**

Where possible, travel light. Baggage space on safari is limited to medium suitcase or soft bag per person plus reasonable amount of hand luggage. There is 15 Kilogram per person limit on all flights to the wildlife sanctuaries. Excess luggage must be stored in your arrival hotel.

### **WATER:**

You will find many different of opinion of what is safe and what is not. We recommend for peace of mind, to drink local Bottled Mineral water. It is important to drink plenty of water especially during the hotter months. We would recommend that guests drink at least 2 to 3 litres of water per day to limit the effects of dehydration.

### **HEALTH:**

East Africa is a safe and secure destination; however, it is a good idea to take a few precautions. Kindly consult your GP or local doctor at least 6 weeks before you travel, with regards:

Malaria prophylactics. East Africa is a known malaria area and preventive measures are essential. You are advised to take one of the recommended anti-malarial drugs. Also confirm on Yellow Fever Vaccine compliance. Be sure to wear long sleeved shorts and trousers after sunset and spray the exposed parts of your body with a mosquito repellent spray

Remember to protect yourself from direct sun rays with sunscreen cream or safari hat.

### **DIETARY REQUIREMENTS:**

For those guests with specific dietary requirement, please ensure the Hotel is notified prior to travel

### **GRATUITIES:**

As a guideline and dependent on how happy you are, we would suggest the following:

The General Hotel/Lodge/Camp Staff - Approximately US\$ 10.00 per person per day

Driver Guides – Approximately US\$ 15.00 to US\$ 20.00 per person per day
