04 OCT: ARRIVAL TO KIRINYAGA

Your adventure begins as we meet our trusty Landcruiser, our home-on-wheels for the journey. You leave Nairobi behind, driving through rolling hills to arrive at the foot of Mount Kenya. By evening, you're settling into the serene **Castle Forest Lodge**.

CASTLE FOREST LODGE



05-OCT: OL PAJETA

After breakfast, the cool, fresh air invites a gentle nature walk through the lush indigenous forest, a perfect introduction to Kenya's tranquil beauty. You will later continue northwards (approx. 2 hours). Your destination is the renowned **Oi Pejeta Conservancy**, arriving in time for lunch at **Serena Sweetwaters**. The afternoon is spent on a game drive in this sanctuary, coming eye-to-eye with rhinos and learning about vital conservation efforts under the vast Kenyan sky.

06-OCT-ABARDARE

A morning drive (approx. 2.5 hours) brings you into the heart of the **Aberdare Highlands**. You will have lunch at Abardare country club as you bid your guide bye till tomorrow. The ark lodge vehicle will take you for a game drive as you later proceed to check into the iconic **The Ark Lodge**, designed like a giant game-viewing vessel. The day and night are spent on its decks, watching elephants, buffalo, and hyenas gather at the forest waterhole—a spectacle of wilderness activity from the comfort of our balcony.

07 OCT- LK NAIVASHA

Leaving the highlands, we descend to the sun-drenched shores of Lake Naivasha (~8:30 AM - 12:30 PM). At Sawela Lodge, a new world awaits. An afternoon boat ride glides past hippos and fish eagles. You then step onto Crescent Island for a walking safari, wandering freely amongst zebra, giraffe, and impala—a uniquely intimate communion with nature.

08 OCT-HELL'S GATE

Today, we embrace adventure. Just a 30-minute drive away, you will enter **Hell's Gate National Park**. You pick up your **bikes** and, with your **guide**, cycle past towering cliffs, herds of zebra, and right into the mouth of the dramatic gorge. It's an active, exhilarating day before returning to our comfort at Sawela Lodge. This is where the famous Tomb Raider II featuring Angelina Jolie was filmed.

09-OCT-LK ELEMENTAITA

A leisurely morning leads to a short transfer (~10:00 AM - 12:00 PM) north to the serene Lake Elementaita. At Sentrim Elementaita, the alkaline lake shimmers, often dotted with the brilliant pink of flamingos. An afternoon game drive in Soysambu Conservancy offers more classic safari vistas against the backdrop of this peaceful, lesser-known lake.

10 & 11 OCT-MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

We embark on the iconic journey to the Masai Mara (~8:00 AM - 2:00 PM). The landscape slowly transforms into the rolling golden grasslands you've dreamed of. Checking into Sentrim Mara, the excitement is palpable. An afternoon game drive offers your first taste of the Mara's legendary abundance—the Great Migration may very well be painting the horizon with movement.

The second day is of deep immersion. Morning and afternoon game drives bookend a day of pure discovery. We search for prides of lions, elusive leopards in the riverine thickets, and vast herds of wildebeest. Every moment is a potential scene from a documentary, a story waiting to be witnessed.

12-OCT CULTURE & FAREWELL

We enjoy a final Mara morning—perhaps a visit to a **Masai Village** or the **Beads Museum** to connect with the region's rich cultural heritage. After lunch at the charming **Art Café in Narok**, we begin our journey back to Nairobi (approx. 5-6 hours), filled with unforgettable memories, arriving at **JKIA** in the evening for our onward flights.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

All visitors to Kenya must have a valid passport with at least 4 consecutive blank pages.

Any applicable Travel Documents are the responsibility of the traveller. For further information on Travel permit requirements visitors are advised to contact their nearest Kenyan Embassy or Consulate.

LOCAL SIM CARDS:

They can be purchased at the airport on arrival as they require passport verification. You can load our local currency in the M-Pesa app which makes it easy for you to purchase without getting refunds inconveniences.

WI-FI:

City hotels have it available in all areas but it might be limited the common areas in the lodges depending on the lodge.

POWER:

The city and Town hotels have 24-hour coverage but in the lodges within the parks, they always advise on when they put off their generators mostly at midnight and in the afternoon when all guests have left for afternoon game drives. For special considerations like CPAP machine use, it is good to notify the hotel earlier.

VOLTAGE:

220 Volts/AC50Hz. Sockets are UK style, 3 pin square plugs. Power is from the National Grid in the city/major towns and generator with inverter back up in the Safari Lodges and Camps.



CURRENCY:

Foreign currency must be changed at the Bank, Bureau de Change, and Hotel/Safari lodge/Camp/Resort. Major Credit Cards, Master card, Visa, American Express, are usually accepted throughout the country. Where credit cards are accepted, the payment will normally be recorded in US\$ regardless of the card's default currency.

CLOTHING:

Dress is mainly informal and should be comfortable as well as practical. Something warm should be brought along for early morning and evenings. Safari clothes are available from hotels/lodges/camps.

BAGGAGE:

Where possible, travel light. Baggage space on safari is limited to medium suitcase or soft bag per person plus reasonable amount of hand luggage. There is 15 Kilogram per person limit on all flights to the wildlife sanctuaries. Excess luggage must be stored in your arrival hotel.

WATER:

You will find many different of opinion of what is safe and what is not. We recommend for peace of mind, to drink local Bottled Mineral water. It is important to drink plenty of water especially during the hotter months. We would recommend that guests drink at least 2 to 3 litres of water per day to limit the effects of dehydration.

DRINKS:

Drinks are only paid for in the All Inclusive packages. Drinks are always charged separately from the Full Board package

HEALTH:

East Africa is a safe and secure destination; however, it is a good idea to take a few precautions. Kindly consult your GP or local doctor at least 6 weeks before you travel, with regards:

Malaria prophylactics. East Africa is a known malaria area and preventive measures are essential. You are advised to take one of the recommended anti-malarial drugs. Also confirm on Yellow Fever Vaccine compliance. Be sure to wear long sleeved shorts and trousers after sunset and spray the exposed parts of your body with a mosquito repellent spray

Remember to protect yourself from direct sun rays with sunscreen cream or safari hat.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS:

For those guests with specific dietary requirement, please ensure the Hotel is notified prior to travel

GRATUITIES:

As a guideline and dependent on how happy you are, we would suggest the following:

The General Hotel/Lodge/Camp Staff - Approximately U\$ 10.00 per person per day
Driver Guides – Approximately US\$ 20.00 to US\$ 40.00 per person per day

PHOTOGRAPHY AND BINOCULARS:

It is good to carry along binoculars as we may not provide for everyone and also a great camera to capture the moments.

Please ensure that you have sought permission before photographing local people and their villages. If in doubt, please check with your guide.
